

Uncover global pesticide threats

Why: Threats from pesticides and other chemicals in agribusiness.

How: Cross-border project to uncover the deadly and dangerous pesticides.

Who: Coordinated by Investigative Reporting Denmark, Project leaders: Mark Schapiro and Nils Mulvad.

What: A new way to collaborate on cross-border investigative journalism, using heavy data-analysis, comparing standards and threats in different countries from Russia to India, US and Europe, sharing findings and methods - and publishing the findings for mobile presentation. Open to other centers round the world - open to media partners.

Global problems vs. local coverage — new frontiers for investigative journalism

Why: Environment is global, but media coverage is local and lack new, cross-border investigative methods and new publishing platform on mobile devices.

What: Investigative Reporting Denmark - a new center to focus on environmental investigative journalism. working and sharing findings cross-border.

How: We will integrate heavy data-analysis, social and mobile media, cross-border work with traditional investigative methods.

Who: Experienced Danish investigative journalists with a global network of investigative reporters (and centers).
